Grape Varieties	60% Merlot, 30% Cabernet-Sauvignon, 10% Petit Verdot
Viticulture	Our culture methods are traditional and respect the ecosystem of the land where the vines are grown. (HEV certification, level 3 : High Environmental Value and ISO 14001).
	
Wine Making	After selective sorting, maceration for 15 to 30 days in tanks (stainless steel). Each operation is understood according to the vintage and the raw material. Each tank is analyzed independently. The tasting of the juices will, after the tasting of the grapes and the sanitary report made in the vineyard, determine the process applied
Ageing	During 12 months, 60% in barrels including 25% new. The rest is aged in vats.
Tasting	The wine is deep garnet-red with an attractive, delicate nose, featuring ripe red and black fruit aromas. It is full-bodied on the palate with perfectly balanced ripe tannin and freshness following through in a long aftertaste.
