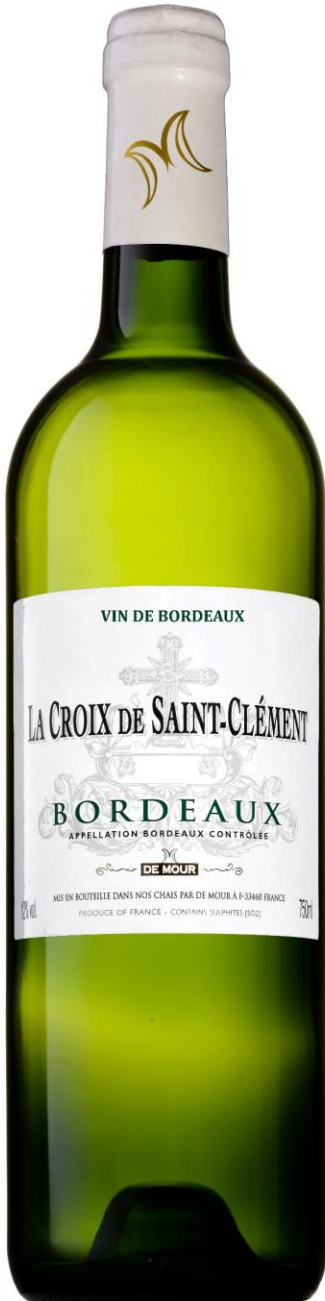


LA CROIX DE SAINT-CLÉMENT

AOC	Bordeaux - White
Soils	Sandy-gravel and clay-limestone
Age of the vines	10 to 20 years on average
Density of plantation	3000 pieds/ ha
Wine making	Short pruning (guyot and single), harvest mechanical. Cold breaking-in, fermentation alcoholic with temperature control.
Ageing	5 months in stainless steel vats on fine lees
Blend	80% Sauvignon Blanc 20% Sémillon
Tasting	This dry white Bordeaux wine has a light yellow straw color with green reflects. Very aromatic and very pleasant and long on the palate.
Cellaring	3 to 4 years
